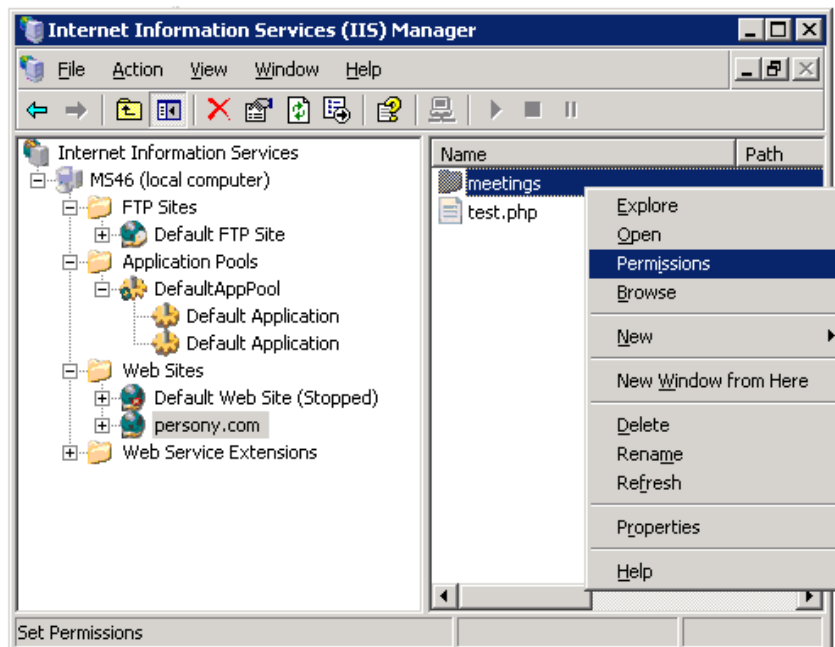
WEB SITE CONFIGURATION PROCEDURE

INSTALLATION

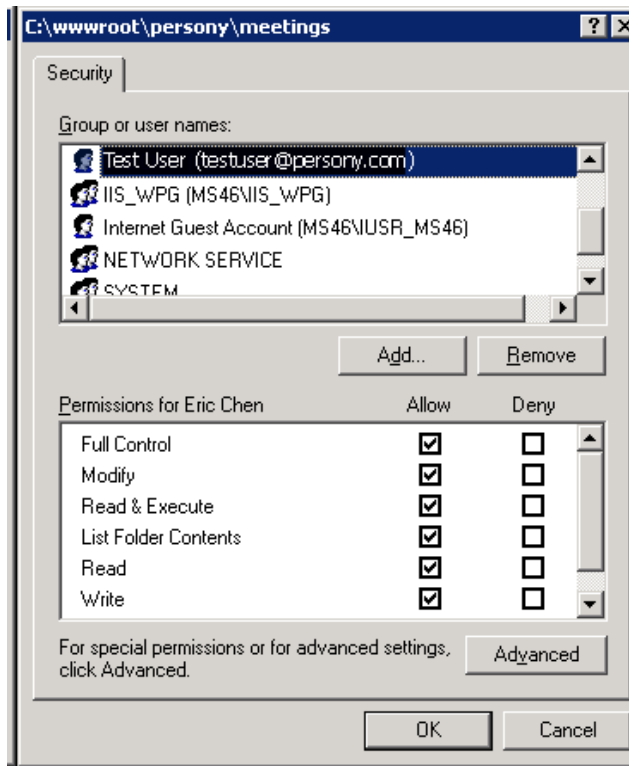
1. To configure a WEB site to host your meetings, you need the FTP address of the Internet server, a user name and password.
2. Create a directory, at the root of the path and give it a significant name like, webconference, without majuscule.

CONFIGURATION

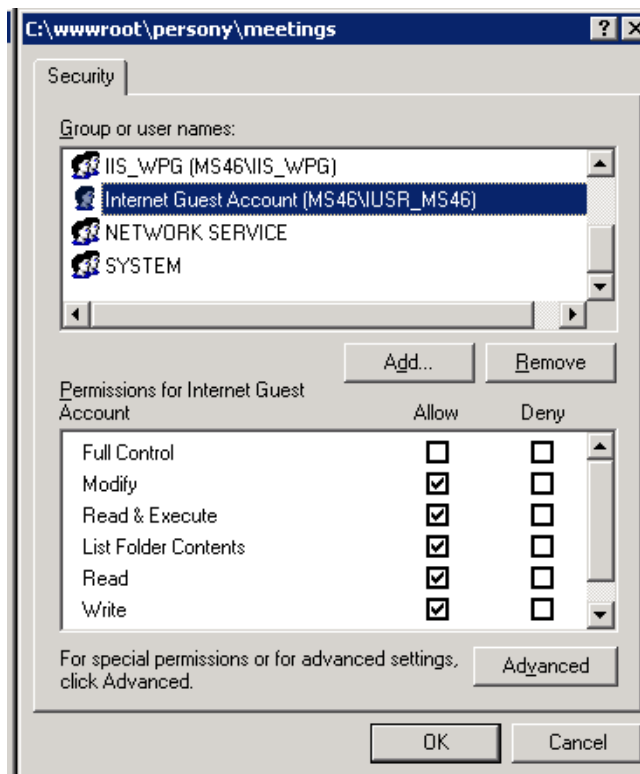
1. The directory created needs permissions. If the client use an Apache server, permissions tights for the directory require level 755 (Read/Write - owner and group).
2. In the case of Microsoft Internet Server, Internet Information Services (IIS), follows a configuration example. The WEB site is named here persony.com and the directory is meetings. Clicking with the right button of your mouse over the directory to select, you mat access its permissions.



3. Select a user, in that case, Test User, and give him all permissions Full Control/Modify/Read & Execute./List Folder Contents/Read/Write



4. Now select an Internet guest account, Internet Guest Account and give him the same level of permissions, except Full Control.



5. Finally, still with the right button of your mouse, click on the WEB site name and select Properties. In Documents, uncheck Enable default content page, add index.html. This authorize direct access to your meetings.
